



## **4-H Poster Contest**

Posters are due at the next meeting on	

4-H posters provide an opportunity for you to express your ideas on what 4-H means to you. The message of your poster and the creativity of your artwork are what you will be judged on at the contest.

## **Poster Rules**

- a. Posters may be made by any 4-H'er by a club or by a team of club members.
- b. Posters may be horizontal only.
- c. Posters must be 14 x 22 inches.
- d. Name, address, county, and age of the 4-H member(s) should be clearly written on the back of each poster.
- e. 4-H is to be the topic for the poster.
- f. Well known cartoon figures cannot be used because they are copyrighted-- such as Marvel Super Heroes, Disney characters, Ninja turtles, Lego characters or Pokémon characters, etc. No Football, NASCAR Drivers, Actors, etc.
- g. Three dimensional objects or materials which extend 1/8 inch or more above the surface of the poster may not be used. **NO GLITTER ON THE POSTER!**
- h. If the 4-H emblem is used on the poster, do not place text or other image on top of it. The 4-H emblem should not appear screened under words or graphics. No photo, drawing, symbol, word or other figure or object may be placed on or obscure the 4-H emblem.
- i. The poster design must be original in design and layout. Copies from previous year winning posters will be disqualified.

## **Helpful Hints**

A poster makes people stop, read and remember. Busy is not better when designing a poster.

- 1. Plan the kind of poster you want.
- 2. Make your poster say something.
- 3. An effective poster should have one main idea, knowing your idea is the first step.
- 4. Think about your basic design before you put it together. Make sure everything will fit before you put in together. Check your spelling!
- 5. Make your message brief and direct, a person should be able to read it at a glance. Remember, a short message with large letters is best.
- 6. Is the lettering neat and large enough to be easily read? A 14 x 22 in. poster should have letters from <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> to 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> in high.

Color Combinations in order of their effectiveness:

- 1. Black letters on Yellow background
- 2. Green letters on White background
- 3. Blue letters on White background
- 4. White letters on Blue background
- 5. Black letters on White background
- 6. Never same color on same color
