 - Genesis bows are usually \$80-125 online
 - Compound and Recurve bows vary in price (Tom's Sporting Goods on Buffalo Trail has the requirements for these bows and can help fit youth to an appropriate bow)
- Arrows
- Arrow quiver (attach to belt or pocket)
- Wrist guard
- Finger guard
- Bow case (optional)

- If you practice at the Archery Club at a time other than 4-H practice then you pay \$3/person leave payment in the drop box at the door as you enter the practice floor.
