

## **4-H Shooting Sports 2026 - Archery Discipline**

Signing Day – Tuesday, October 21, 2025 at 6:00-7:30 PM  
at 4-H Office – 511 W. 2<sup>nd</sup> North St. Room 204

### **Requirements to Join**

- Age Requirements
  - Open to 4<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders, as of Jan. 1, 2026.
  - Any member under 16 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian over 21 at practices and events. A 16-year-old member cannot bring underage siblings or other 4-H'ers.
- Completed paperwork – registration form, health form, code of conduct form, school permission form (if in public school), archery club membership form.
- Registration Fees - \$60 4-H fee, \$60 Archery Club fee = Total \$120.
- Attendance – required to attend the 4-H Archery Jamboree.
- Registration is limited to the first 20 after that a waiting list will be started.
- Band – Free download and communication app to communicate with parents and coaches. This is the ONLY form of communication for Shooting Sports.

### **Required Equipment**

- Bow – refer to Archery Jamboree guidelines for correct equipment standards
  - Genesis Compound
    - 4-H has 2 right hand and 1 left hand Genesis bows that can be shared
  - Compound
  - Recurve
- Arrows (Genesis arrows provided by 4-H)
- Wrist guard
- Finger guard
- Optional equipment
  - Bow case (highly recommended)
  - Arrow quiver (attach to belt or pocket)

### **Schedule**

- Safety Meeting – REQUIRED on December 16 at 5-6pm
- Practice is held at Morristown Archery Club – 2953 Cherokee Park Rd, Morristown
- January - April – every Tuesday at 4-6 pm (may adjust times based on participation numbers)

- If inclement weather, we will follow Hamblen County Schools schedule for the day. Delay – practice, Closed – no practice.
- 4-H Archery Jamboree – April 10-11, 2026 (date based on bow)

#### **4-H Registration Fee Covers**

- TN 4-H Archery Jamboree
- Shooting Sports Team shirt
- 4-H Insurance
- Practice location fees

#### **Archery Club Fee (due annually on January 1)**

- \$60 for Family – covers members of the immediate family
- One per family
- Provides access to the club for non-4-H practice times
- If you practice at the Archery Club at a time other than 4-H practice then you pay \$5/person, leave payment in the drop box at the door as you enter the practice floor.

#### **Other Opportunities**

- 4-H Target Smart Camp (5<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grade) – May 25-29, 2026 in Crossville, TN

#### **Fundraising**

- All athletes are required to participate in fundraising with a goal of \$200+.
- Fundraising keeps the registration fee from being increased.
