4-H Piggy Bank Pageant

America Saves is a program designed to help youth learn the importance of financial health and saving money. By creating your own piggy bank you can start saving towards a goal of your own. Piggy banks will be due at the next 4-H activity on _____

Rules are as follows:

- ✓ Piggy banks must be made by an individual youth.
- ✓ Piggy banks do not have to be in the shape of a pig.
- ✓ Piggy banks must have an opening to put money in and a way to take money out without breaking or destroying it.
- ✓ Only one entry per member.
- ✓ Piggy banks should be made from recycled materials. Do NOT use anything glass.
- ✓ Use any supplies you want! (paint, sequins, paper, stickers) but NO GLITTER.
- ✓ You cannot simply buy a bank and decorate it.
- ✓ Piggy banks can be no bigger than 12 in x 12 in x 12 in.
- ✓ Be sure to label your pig with your name, teacher, grade and school.

It's important to save money so you can buy or do the things you want in the future. Use your creativity to make a Piggy Bank to hold the money you save!


4-H Chick Chain
