

What is Junior 4-H Camp?

Junior Camp is a 5 day summer camp through the University of Tennessee Extension-Hamblen County. The camp provides youth with hands on educational activities to actively engage them in learning but also provides fun adventures, recreational activities and fosters new friendships. Campers are well-supervised by the 4-H agent, camp counselors, parent volunteers and residential camp staff. The camp is accredited by the American Camping Association.

Who Can Attend?

This camp is for youth grades 4th–6th.

How Are the Facilities?

Camp facilities are designed for the safety and comfort for all who attend. Facilities include spacious and air conditioned cabins (with shower facilities) dining hall and Olympic-size swimming pool!

Will My Child be Safe?

The camp includes a medical & health facility under the direction of a Registered Nurse. If needed, the hospital and health clinic are approximately 4 miles from the camp. All adults are background checked, screened and 4-H camp leader trained.
